The United We Can family thanks God for the salvation of Jean Pierre “JP” Cloete, Justin and Crystal Dreyer, and Francoise Human, along with all the other individuals who are experiencing the power of God in their lives in Cape Town, South Africa!

JP came from a broken family and hated his alcoholic father. Even though he was exposed to church from a young age, JP did not understand the message. He allowed his life to be directed by alcohol and drugs. Once he committed his life to God, he was transformed. JP has forgiven his father and is restoring that relationship. He is now a worship leader and has aspirations to travel the world with his group, Sound of Victory.

Like JP, both Crystal and Justin thought they too would remain lost in a dark world of drugs and crime. Crystal was caught up in drug addiction for over six years. Her life at home was physically and emotionally abusive and she turned to drugs and eventually got into an abusive relationship which resulted in a pregnancy. At the point where she no longer cared about her life, Crystal was saved through the ministry of Victory Outreach. She turned her life over to Jesus Christ and is now a worship leader in the church. Crystal’s husband Justin has a similar story and before his salvation, he fell into a life of gangs, drugs, and crime. Not only has Justin found the love of his life in his wife Crystal, he fell in love with God and has heard the call. He now serves as a Youth G.A.N.G. leader in his church. Both he and Crystal are part of a team being sent out to begin a new church in Johannesburg.

Francoise Human grew up in a Christian home and his father was the senior pastor of a church. He rejected anything to do with God and the church. He was a good student, enrolled in university, and had a good job and a wife. He fell into gang activity and practiced it while leading his double life as an employed student. He began using drugs and in a short time became an addict and lost everything, including his wife of ten years. Francoise has given his heart to the Lord and has never looked back. He’s now a successful leader in the Recovery Home and has become a role model for others hoping to find salvation through the Victory Outreach Recovery home.
